Lenten Fasting & Abstaining

Here is a friendly reminder about fasting On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday: healthy adults (including teens) are to eat ONE full meal only, and no meat. No snacking, and other meals need to be small.

On Fridays of Lent, no meat is to be eaten. Remember the spirit of this, don't replace your steak dinner with a lobster dinner, rather, go simple.

All through Lent, is to be a time of prayer, fasting and penitence. So make sure these are incorporated into your practices.

The more one puts into this, the more one gets out of it!
