Joint Statement form Bishops Pepe & Calvo

As many of you are aware, there is a bill in the Nevada Legislature to make doctor prescribed suicide legal in Nevada. The bill is SB 261. A basic principle of Catholic moral teaching is the value of all human life. Legalizing doctor prescribed suicide diminishes the value of life, and is an attack on all human dignity. We urge you to use the information which is provided below to make sure that your legislators know that you value human life, and that you oppose legalizing doctor prescribed suicide.

It will bring up "Share Your Opinion With Your Legislators". Select SB 261 from the "Select Bill" drop down, and then go to the "Your View" line, and click on "Against". This will register your opposition to Doctor Prescribed Suicide.
