Lenten Regulations

It is this time of year when most of us are a bit confused about what the proper observances are for the season Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast. Fasting is generally understood to be 1 meal without snacking during the day. Many people mitigate the observances with 2 small meals that do not equal the sum of the 3rd. All Catholics without medical problems are obliged to the law of fast, beginning at age 18 and continuing through age 59. Ash Wednesday, All Fridays of Lent and Good Friday, are days of abstinence. This law applies to all Catholics 14 years of age and older. No meat or visible meat products in other foods may be consumed, including wild game, fowl, lamb, pork or beef. Soy, milk products, eggs, cheese, fish and shellfish are permitted.
